



Rules of the Road



A phone call home will be made to discuss the behavior and decide upon a plan of action.

A behavior violation will be sent home and need to be signed after you discuss the behavior with your child.

Every student will begin the day on green and if he/she moves colors, they will have the chance to move back.

**Our classroom will use a stoplight for discipline. Each child will begin every day with their clothespin on green. If an unacceptable behavior is noticed, the student will receive a warning before moving to yellow. Once on yellow, the student will have the chance to improve his/her behavior and move back to green, but if this is not the case a behavior violation notice will be sent home to the parents so that they and their child can discuss the behavior. I ask that the notice be signed so that I know the parents received it. If for some reason, the student is having a really hard time and has already received a warning on yellow, they will move to red on the stoplight, and I will make a phone call home to discuss the behavior.*

In some cases, a child may need to receive a consequence from another supervising adult in the building such as lunchroom supervisors, special teachers, or the librarian. In this case, the school wide discipline plan will go into affect. This will also hold true if the behavior is severe.
